Welcome from the site team

Welcome to the first edition of the Kier Newsletter for the Southfields School project. These regular publications are aimed at keeping you updated with progress on site.

We will highlight recent construction works, as well as what to expect in the upcoming months.

About the project

Kier has been appointed by Peterborough City Council to construct a new-build extension to the school, linking together the existing infant and junior schools. It will be constructed from pad foundations, a structural steel frame, curtain walling, strip footings, brick and blockwork.

This new extension will house six classrooms, WC facilities, a new ICT suite, meeting and administration rooms, and a new office for the Headteacher.

The extension will enable the school to increase their capacity to 600+ students, fulfilling a much-needed increase in demand.

Upcoming activities on site

You will have seen some temporary classrooms being delivered to site, and we are carrying out some minor paving works. These are all part of an Enabling Works package, so that the school can relocate some operations ahead of the main works.

The main contract will then begin on the 26 May 2015 after the half term break, and is programmed to complete in March 2016.
