


# STIBBINGTON 2019 KIT LIST


## FEEDBACK MEETING

Stibbington Centre is part of **Cambridgeshire Environmental Education Service (CEES)**, which is a service provided for schools by Cambridgeshire County Council.

The Centre offers the opportunity for pupils to sample a residential experience for a few days in a friendly, hospitable environment, not far from home. The courses offered at the Centre are designed to support the National Curriculum, with a particular emphasis on Science, Geography and History, together with Education for Sustainable Development.



The Centre is located in the North West corner of Cambridgeshire, beside the A1 near Wansford. It is 10 miles west of Peterborough and 20 miles north of Huntingdon.
