Please do be assured that we try our very best to work with parents to ensure that your child is happy and safe in school. If you have a concern, please do speak to the Class Teacher in the first instance. If you feel that the issue is not resolved then a meeting with the Leader of the Key Stage can be organised. A meeting with one of our Key Stage Deputies would then follow. The Governors would only become involved to check that the school procedures had been followed. There is very little that we cannot resolve with meeting and talking so please do come and see us.

Please do remember to telephone the school office to report any absences. If at all possible it is useful to have some evidence from the GP or dentist appointment cards to verify the absence. If your child has been prescribed medication we are happy to photocopy the label of the bottle which will provide proof of illness. The Local Authority Attendance Office request that we provide as much evidence as possible and in the long run this will also support you should there ever be a need to meet with either our own Attendance Officer or the Local Authority Attendance Officers.

Please remember to be safe when parking outside of school. We have had several complaints from Parents about others parking on the grass verges outside of the school gates which is making it very dangerous for children and adults to walk to school. May we remind you that we have several safe parking areas with routes that bypass the roads at the Community Centre and Glatton Drive. We will be doing more audits on parking over the next term so please do your best to park safely.

As we find our way towards the hotter weather, please can we ask that you provide school with a named sun hat and bottle of Sun lotion (Factor 50) so that your child can protect themselves from the sun when it arrives.
