

February 2018. How quick is this year going by?

We have had a lovely Eastern European Coffee last week. The litter picking with the community cadets was a big success.

We have lots of children currently unwell with colds and sniffles. Please note that minimum attendance for children is 96% therefore it is very important that if at all possible you can bring the children into school having had medicine administered. Generally after having the medication some children seem brighter and for a few hours and most do seem able to manage the school day. Most penicillin based medications are taken three times a day which would allow for the child to be dosed before school, when they are home and before bed.

If your child is off school and has prescribed medication, please let the welfare office copy the medication packet/bottle as evidence. You must also follow the school policy and procedures for having medication in school (available on our school website).

Please where possible try to make medical or dental appointments out of school hours.

Children need to be at their desk for registration at 8:50am. The school doors open at 8:40am giving them time to hang up their outdoor clothes, put their home learning books in the correct place and be at their desk for registration. Missing the instructions for the day really does have a massive impact on the children.

Please also be prompt collecting the children at the end of the school day. Staff often have to be in meetings immediately after school and the staff at the Welfare Office also meet with parents at the end of the school day. It is frustrating for the children, after a full day in school if they are not collected on time.

We have recently had a number of parents come to see us because they are upset that they have overheard or had unkind comments made to them on the playground from other parents. We need to treat others how we would like to be treated and not making assumptions. As you can appreciate we all have our own stories and past events which have shaped the way we are today. So on this note could we please ask parents to be kind and respectful of other parents whilst on the school grounds. None of us know the circumstances or background of other families and it is important that we always speak kindly towards and of others. Please also be mindful that your language and comments could be overheard by the children.

We are continuing to monitor parking at the school entrance. Please remember to park in our designated 'Park & Stride' car parks. We have asked Parking Enforcement Officers to continue to randomly ride by. We understand that several parents have received parking tickets so it is important that you park respectfully and legally.

School staff have also noticed many children riding their bikes and scooters on the school grounds. We have to be mindful of younger children walking with parents and elderly guardians collecting children as they may get knocked over and sustain injuries. Anyone seen riding their bikes or scooters will instantly receive a green light from member of staff.

The Welfare team continue to work with children daily and support the lunchtime Nurture groups in which the children have time working on activities. Last term children made worry dolls, friendship bracelets, dream catchers and then some Christmas crafts.
