

## **Southfields Primary School Code of Conduct for Outdoor Learning Areas**

You are expected to be polite and courteous at all times.

We want all Southfields children to be able to enjoy the outdoor learning opportunities in our school grounds. To do this we have put in place guidelines to ensure everyone is safe and respect is shown for all of these areas along with the living and growing things found there. The following guidelines may help you to achieve these standards.

- ✓ Always walk round planted areas or mini beast habitats, if there is a path use it.
- ✓ Always walk in the environmental area, if you rush you may forget to be careful.
- ✓ Respect and care for growing and living things in our environment.
- ✓ Think safety- always remember the safety of everyone, think about what effect your actions may have on others. ü Look after the environment and put all litter in the bins.
- ✓ Always ask an adult before picking berries or anything to eat
- ✓ Use equipment correctly only climb on climbing apparatus.
- ✓ Use garden tools sensibly and safely.
- ✓ Always clear and tidy up after use, returning equipment to the correct place.
- ✓ Only go near the pond area with an adult.
- ✓ When instructed wear gloves or other protective clothing.
- ✓ Look after all property, if you accidentally break or destroy something please tell an adult, another child may injure themselves.
- ✓ Remember team work. ü Behaviour remember, you are responsible for your actions.
- ✓ After working or playing in outdoor areas you should wash your hands.
- ✓ Always listen to the adults and show consideration for these outdoor learning opportunities.
